Start: Copenhagen - End: Stockholm

Day 1 Arrive Copenhagen (2 Nights)

Welcome to Copenhagen. Relax and unwind after checking in or take a stroll through the city. Tonight meet your Travel Director and fellow travellers for dinner at the hotel. (D) Hotel: AC Bella Sky

Day 2 Copenhagen Sightseeing and Free Time

This morning, your Local Specialist takes you on a sightseeing tour of this wonderful city, including the major sights such as the Little Mermaid, Nyhavn, the Royal Amalienborg Palace and the Carlsberg Glyptotek. You'll have free time to visit one of the galleries or do some shopping. (SB)

Day 3 Copenhagen - Oslo

Today, travel from Denmark to Sweden via the Helsingor to Helsingborg ferry. Journey past Gothenburg and along Sweden's scenic coastline to Norway where you will spend the night in the capital city of Oslo. (SB) Hotel: Radisson Blu Alna

Day 4 Oslo Sightseeing - Vrådal

This morning, your Local Specialist will show you the highlights of Oslo including views of the medieval fortress Akershus, the Town Hall and the Royal Palace. Visit Vigeland Sculpture Park where you will find the world's largest sculpture exhibition made by a single artist. This afternoon start exploring the impressive Norwegian countryside as you travel towards the Telemark region, famed for being the home of the original and oldest skiing technique. Tonight enjoy dinner at your hotel. (SB, D) **Hotel: Quality Strand**

Day 5 Vrådal - Bergen (2 Nights)

Start your day with a spectacular drive that takes you through the mountains and around the Hardangerfjord. Arrive in Bergen, Norway's second-biggest city famed for its shipping, aguaculture and subsea technology industry. (SB) Hotel: Zander K

Day 6 Bergen Sightseeing and Free Time

Today experience the history of this picturesque city on your orientation tour. See the 13th century Haakon's Hall and the bustling fish market. You'll have free time to explore the harbour area and the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Bryggen which is the old wharf of the city. (SB)

Day 7 Bergen - Sognefjord (Hafslo)

Leave Bergen and see Tvindefossen waterfall on our way to marvel at the Sognefjord, the longest and deepest fjord in the world. Dinner will be at your hotel this evening. (SB, D) Hotel: Eikum

Day 8 Sognefjord (Hafslo) - Fagernes

Enjoy spectacular mountain scenery today as you pass high mountain lakes and Jotunheimen National Park where Scandinavia's highest mountain, Galdhøpiggen rises over 2,400 metres. (SB, D) Hotel: Scandic Valdres

Day 9 Fagernes - Lillehammer - Karlstad

Travel to Lillehammer, host of the Winter Olympics in 1994. The scenery will change as you drive through lush forests along gorgeous lakes towards Sweden. Spend the night in Karlstad, on the shores of the biggest lake of them all, Lake Vänern. (SB) Hotel: Scandic Winn/Scandic Klarälven

Day 10 Karlstad - Örebro - Stockholm (2 Nights)

This morning visit Örebro, a lively university town. View the castle dominating the town centre before continuing to Stockholm. (SB)

Hotel: Park Inn by Radisson Hammarby Sjöstad

Day 11 Stockholm Sightseeing and Free Time

Today get to know this beautiful city on your sightseeing tour with a Local Specialist. View the medieval Storkyrkan, the Town Hall and the Royal Palace. Spend time discovering the museums or fashionable stores or consider an Optional Experience in the afternoon. Tonight dine with your fellow travellers and celebrate this memorable trip. (SB, D)
